Since June 20, the artist Jane Gemayel has been successfully exhibiting several of her artworks in her exhibition entitled "Au cœur d'un regard", which is being held at the Galerie Adriano Ribolzi in Monaco until September 23. This unique exhibition highlights the various artistic currents explored by Jane Gemayel, as well as presenting her new series entitled "*Hommage à Rodin*". The opening evening was a great success, with Jane Gemayel's poetic and feminine paintings captivating art lovers and connoisseurs alike.

"Au cœur d'un regard" provides visitors with a wonderful artistic experience showcasing the talent of Jane Gemayel. The Galerie Adriano Ribolzi, located in Monaco, offers an ideal setting for this exhibition, offering a harmonious blend of contemporary art and sobriety.

Jane Gemayel is renowned for her art across diverse artistic currents, combining traditional and contemporary techniques to create original artworks that reconsider the boundaries of art. Visitors to the exhibition have the chance to discover or rediscover the « *Woman* » and « *News as Muse* » series, as well as her exclusive new collection, « *Hommage à Rodin* », inspired by original sketches by the French sculptor. This event takes place in a gallery that the artist is already familiar with, since she presented the collection "*The Prophet*" there in 2015 on the occasion of a book signing of the eponymous book, paying homage to the poems of Khalil Gibran through the creation of unique drawings illustrating them.

"Au cœur d'un regard" is a rare opportunity to delve into Jane Gemayel's rich artistic universe. Her artwork evokes deep emotions, inviting viewers to immerse themselves in a world of beauty and sensitivity. This exhibition represents a unique opportunity to discover the artist's evolution over the years and to appreciate her view of the world.

This Monegasque exhibition runs from 20 June to 23 September at the Galerie Adriano Ribolzi, where, for the duration of a summer, Jane Gemayel reveals herself in the heart of a glance.

About Jane Gemayel

Jane Gemayel is a Canadian painter, born in Ontario, who lives and works in Monaco, where she has set up her studio. This space, overlooking the city, evokes a haven of peace sheltered from view. Her work was initially guided by the literary work *The Prophet* by Khalil Gibran, which she discovered in her youth, as well as several poets and writers who have continually inspired her creations. A self-taught artist, her sure pencil stroke gives her a solid base for drawing portraits of women or the infinity of the world, and she never stops giving thanks to the poetry of her favourite author. Within her precise black ink drawings are arabesque motifs and dense lines executed with energy, from which emerge feminine curves in pastel shades, now delivering her own reinterpretation of Rodin's delicate, sensual works.
